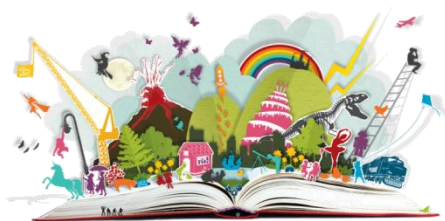


Enrichment Activities
