Physical Development



In PE, we will be focussing on moving in different ways, such as slithering, crawling, running and practising spatial awareness.

We will then move onto the topic of dance! We will learn how to listen to songs and music and move in time to the beat.

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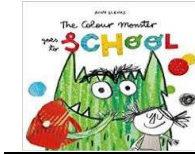


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Literacy



Focus Author: Anna Llenas Writing: From the beginning, the children will have their names displayed outside of our classroom, to become familiar with letters and print. This gives each child a sense of belonging.

Phonics: The children will learn to create symbols and mark making in adult led and child initiated learning.

Maths



We will begin the year by learning all about numbers 0—10 and what they represent. We will look at days of the week and dates and have fun with shape hunts! The children will be learning new routines with visual timetables.



Understanding the world

We will be learning about our similarities and our differences from our topic 'This is me'. In Autumn 2 we will discuss the seasonal change of autumn and the upcoming celebrations and festivals, such as Diwali, Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day and Christmas.
